Duties and responsibilities:

- Leading the business analysis effort for large/complex projects, providing detailed estimates for all business analyst tasks, and co-ordinating business analysis activities.
- Assisting the Project Manager with the creation of initiation documents, stakeholder analysis, and third party software/external vendor evaluations.
- Leading discussions with the business stakeholders to agree project objectives, scope, business benefits and business acceptance criteria.
- Gathering, understanding, documenting and validating business requirements, by engaging with a full range of stakeholders, from sponsor to end user.
- Translating the business requirements into a set of functional and non-functional system requirements, with detailed acceptance criteria.
- Supporting the business departments in the creation, amendment and/or refinement of their business processes, whilst ensuring they retain ownership for them.

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- Gaining formal sign-off for key project documentation (e.g. requirement catalogues and solution specifications).
- Providing the communication link between the business stakeholders and all solution providers, whether internal developers, third party software vendors or a mixture.
- Working closely with third party software vendors to ensure outsourced work packages are clearly documented and understood.
- Assisting the Test Analysts with the preparation of test packs (scenarios and/or scripts).
- Leading the execution of user acceptance testing and co-ordinating business user activities, where necessary.
- Assisting the business departments with software training prior to the deployment of a project, by training the trainer (usually key end users on the project team).
- Assisting the Project Manager with the pre- and post-implementation tasks e.g. change controls, release testing, implementation support, issue tracking and resolution, handover to support, transition to business as usual support.

- An expert on the process and best practices for conducting requirements capture; an individual who leads by example.
- Conscientious and thorough, with an ambition to deliver quality software solutions.
